

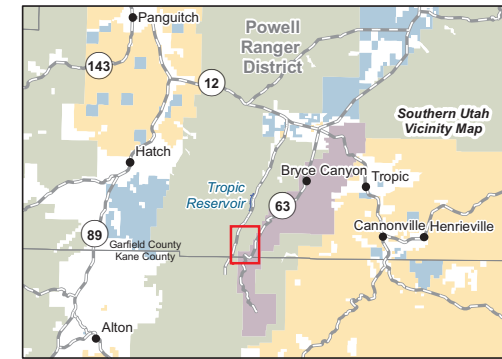

Lightning ignited the **Bridge Fire** on June 14th 8 miles south/southwest of Bryce Canyon City. The Dixie National Forest and Bryce Canyon National Park are managing the fire for resource benefit. The fire is burning in Ponderosa Pine, Pinyon Juniper, Manzanita and Douglas Fir. By allowing this fire to burn naturally, hazardous fuels will be reduced and overall forest health improved. As of June 29th the fire had grown to 254 acres. Smoke from the fire may be visible from Highway 12, Highway 63, East Fork Road and Bryce Canyon National Park. No road closures are in effect at this time. As with all fire operations, public and firefighter safety is the priority.
