



## **MATHIS FIRE UPDATE**

**Today's Update:** Rich Harvey's Type II Interagency Management Team took over management of the incident at 6:00 a.m. this morning. Today's strategy is to extend containment lines, protect power lines in the area, and protect areas surrounding the fire. There is no immediate danger to the town of Kenilworth. There are currently no evacuations planned for the town of Kenilworth or the Aberdeen Mine in Deadman Canyon.

Both air and ground resources are on order to aide in the fire suppression effort.

**TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS:** Public access to the area surrounding the fire is restricted for public safety and to provide for firefighter access. The Emma Park Road is closed to Nine Mile Canyon and the Whitmore Park Road to Emma Park Road is also closed. The Price to Kenilworth Road remains open; however, travel on the Ronco Road and into Cordingly Canyon is restricted north of Kenilworth. The public is urged to avoid the area.

**Current Size:** 1200 acres

**Jurisdiction:** Utah State Division of Forestry Fire and State Lands and Bureau of Land Management

**Containment:** 5%

**Estimated Containment Date:** Unknown

**Cost to Date:** \$450,000

**Cause:** Lightning

**Injuries:** None

**Resources:** 3 crews, 2 helicopters, 9 engines, 1 dozer and 101 personnel

**Cooperating Agencies:** Cooperators include BLM, Forest Service, Counties of Carbon, Emery and Duchesne, State of Utah and the Western Energy Training Center of the College of Eastern Utah.
