**FINAL - Roundabout Wildfire Fact Sheet - FINAL**

**Summary:** Crews made good progress today and full containment has been achieved as of today. Interagency firefighters will continue to mop-up, extinguishing hot spots over the next several days. The public is reminded that the fire danger continues to be at an elevated level and to use precautions during activities in proximity dry vegetation to prevent starting wildfires.

**Start Date:** Monday October 1<sup>st</sup> reported at 4:20 PM

**Location:** Horse Valley area, approximately 20 miles northwest of Cedar City Utah

**Jurisdiction:** Bureau of Land Management Land and State of Utah

**Values at Risk:** Threat is being abated to all values at risk.

**Fire Size:** 2458 acres (Note: one acre is equivalent to one football field).

**Cause:** Human Caused Under Investigation

**Fire Behavior:** interior smoldering

**Closures:** public is being asked to avoid the Kern River Pipeline Road, the Lost Springs Road and the Horse Valley Road for the next few days

**Structures:** none

**Percent Contained:** 100%

**Fuels:** Cheatgrass, mixed brush, and pinyon pine and juniper trees.

**Fire Crews/Resources:** 5 Fire Engines, 3- 20 person hand crews and Miscellaneous Overhead. Totaling approximately 78 personnel today

**Evacuations:** None

**Injuries:** None reported
