Start Date: June 28, 2013

Location: West of Cove Fort, Utah, Millard County

Jurisdiction: Bureau of Land Management, State of Utah

Fire Size: 5,200 Acres (Estimated)

Cause: Lightning

Fire Behavior: Creeping, smoldering

Closures: No road or area closures

Structures: None at this time

Percent Contained: 70%

Fuels: Sage, Grass, Pinyon-Juniper

Fire Crews/Resources: 2 Crews, 3 engines, 1 water tenders, 18 overhead, 1 Type 3 Helicopter

Evacuations: No evacuations are currently in effect.

Injuries: No injuries have been reported.

Summary: Excellent progress made today from crews on the ground have suppressed the fire to minor interior activity. The Type 3 Team is expected to transition the incident back to the local unit on July 2, 2013. Expected full containment expected July 3, 2013 as local crews continue to monitor.

With the continued hot and dry temperatures we encourage everyone to be safe as you enjoy the great outdoors this upcoming Holiday weekend.
