Wildfire Fact Sheet – Briggs Fire

Big John Flat area is now open to camping. The area closure has been modified to indicate that the Big John Flat Road (Forest Road 123) is open, including the spur roads that go to the west.

With the colder and wetter weather, crews will continue working along the Jimmie Reed Road (FR-124) as well as along Grizzly Ridge, removing hazard trees, improving contingency lines, and protecting values at risk. If the weather gets warmer and drier later this weekend, crews will again be putting fire on the ground to direct it to the areas of dead and down timber that most need clearing out.

The lightning caused Briggs fire, located in the remote area of the south fork of North Creek, was discovered on 8/9/2016. The fire is 3,347 acres. Due to recent rains the fire is currently smoldering and creeping in heavy dead and down fuels.

Closures: The temporary area closure for the Briggs Fire is still in effect and will remain until no later than September 15, 2016. This order was issued for protection of public health and safety.

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
IAP Map Briggs


