Clay Springs Fire Update ~ 6/28/2012 - 8p.m.

Start: 06/27/2012@2:15 p.m.

Location: 4 miles south of Oak City

Jurisdiction: State, Forest Service, BLM

Cause: Human

Size: Estimated 45,000 acres

Fuels: Timber, grass, brush, pinyon juniper

Observed Fire Behavior: Running, torching, long-range spotting

Assigned Resources: 13 engines, 3 dozers, 6 water tenders, misc. overhead. Total personnel 52

Injuries: 2

Containment: 15%

Structures Threatened: 75

Evacuations: The communities of Fool Creek and Oak City have been lifted and residents are returning to their residences

Remarks: High winds, dry fuels and low humidity are contributing to rapid spread of the fire to the northeast. Crews aided by air resources continue line construction. Road closures are in effect for Hwy 125 at the junction with Hwy 132, Foot Hill Blvd, and Oak Canyon Road. A Type 2 Incident Management Team has been ordered and is expected to be in place this evening.

Fire managers are reminding everyone to be extremely careful with fire and follow the statewide fire restrictions.
