## 07/09/2012 Update

### Fire Update

No perimeter growth occurred yesterday on the Clay Springs fire. Isolated smoldering in the fire interior was observed but did not grow. The containment line has been completed on the southern perimeter. The contingency dozer line built in the southern portion of the range south of the fire containment line is being improved. This dozer line will remain in place until the fall and will be rehabilitated by the local Forest.

Fire suppression repair is continuing along containment lines to restore the land and minimize the impact of suppression efforts. This includes water bars in dozer and hand lines, scattering of chipped vegetation, fence and water line repairs.

Management of the Oak Springs fire is transitioning back to local agencies and cooperators. A close-out briefing will be held today at 6PM in Oak City with all cooperators and agencies and Southern California Incident Management Team 1 (Type 2). Official transition to a local Type 4 organization will take place Tuesday morning, July 10 at 0600.
