**Name of Fire:** GlenAnna

**Start Date:** June 19, 12:19 pm

**Location:** Bull Claim Hill, 3.5 miles east of Richfield

**Fire Size:** 1,537 acres (increased acreage due to better mapping)

**Cause:** Human-Under Investigation

**Fire Behavior:** isolated hot spots and very little smoke

**Contained:** 90%

**Estimated Containment:** June 21

**Fuels:** grass, brush, isolated heavier fuels

**Fire Crews/Resources:** 2 engines, 2 overhead

**Evacuations:** None

**Additional Information:**

Yesterday, significant progress was made on the fire. Today, fire personnel will continue to focus on containing the burn area. Full containment is expected by this evening.

A Red Flag Warning is in effect from noon today through 11 pm Saturday for wind and low humidity. Fire danger remains extremely high throughout the State of Utah and the public is encouraged to be careful during their outdoor activities.
