### Wildfire Update – Porcupine Fire

**Location:** Porcupine Ridge, Approximately 7 miles southeast of Mayfield, UT

**Elevation:** 9,500 feet

**Cause:** Lightning

**Start Date:** Saturday, July 23, 2016

**Jurisdiction:** Sanpete Ranger District, Manti La Sal National Forest

**Fire Size:** Approximately 278 acres (Note: one acre is equivalent to one football field)

**Fire Summary:** The Porcupine fire remains at 278 acres. It continues to creep and smolder through patchy fuels. Crews will continue to seek opportunities provided by ideal weather to burn out areas of dead and down wood. Tactics are designed to minimize risk to firefighters and achieve resource objectives. Control lines are in place to check fire spread to the north. A primary goal is to reduce fuels while conditions are ideal to create a more resilient landscape that will prevent larger, more extreme fires in the future. Other objectives are to clean up old dead and down wood and reduce conifer encroachment in aspen. Fuels are a mix of grass, litter, subalpine fir and other conifers mixed with aspen. Isolated showers and thunderstorms are forecasted today with a return to drier conditions tomorrow and into the weekend.

**Public Meeting:** There will be a public meeting in Salina to update the community on the progress and management of the Porcupine fire on Wednesday, August 10 beginning at 7:00 PM. The meeting will be held at the Salina Fire Department.

#### Closures:

Road and trail closures remain in place to ensure public and firefighter safety during fire operations.

Roads and trails affected by the Porcupine Fire closure area include:

- (Unnamed Forest Service Road) (FSR # 1272)
- (Unnamed Forest Service Road) (FSR # 1212)
- Victim Ridge Trail (Forest Service Trail) (FST # 127)

These roads are restricted to vehicles under 2500 lbs GVW and will have a 10 mph speed limit:

- Beaver Creek Road (FSR #0290)
- Clear Creek Flat Road to Woods Lake (FSR #0159)

These closures will be in effect from the date signed until August 31, unless rescinded.

**Structures:** No structures threatened.

**Percent Contained:** 0%

**Fire Crews/Resources:** The Skyline Handcrew and Tushar Mountain Wildland Fire Use Module will be monitoring the fire, improving control lines, and conducting burnout operations.
