## **6 Mile Wildfire June 27, 2011 5:00 PM**

**Start Date:** Monday, June 27, 2011 @ 2:43 PM

**Location:** Mile marker 33 on Highway 389 in Arizona, near Fredonia, 70 miles east of St. George, Utah

**Jurisdiction:** Bureau of Indian Affairs

**Cause:** Human—Under Investigation

**Fire Size:** An Estimated 200 acres

**Fire Behavior:** The 2 heads of the fire have been stopped, no forward progression; crews now attacking the flanks

**Contained:** N/A

**Estimated Containment Date:** N/A

**Fuels:** Grass

**Structures Threatened:** Structures threatened

**Resources:** 4 Color Country Engines, 1 Helicopter, 3 Seats, 1 Air Tanker, 1 Air Attack, and various local volunteer resources
