Location: Mile marker 33 on Highway 389 in Arizona, near Fredonia, 70 miles east of St. George, Utah

Jurisdiction: Bureau of Indian Affairs

Cause: Human—Under Investigation

Fire Size: Acreage has been confirmed by GPS at 650 acres

Contained: Contained on Tuesday, June 28, 2011 at 6:00 p.m.

Fuels: Grass, pinyon, and juniper trees

Structures Threatened: Structures no longer threatened; several power lines damaged

Resources: 1 Southern Paiute Agency Crew, 6 Color Country Engines, volunteer resources, and various other overhead

Evacuations: Evacuations have been lifted
