Wildfire Fact Sheet- DI Ranch

Summary: Firefighters were successful in burning out a non-vegetated wash to make significant containment progress on the DI Ranch Fire today. No structures were damaged or lost today and the fire is now 900 acres in size.

Start Date: Thursday, August 9, 2012 8:27 p.m.

Location: Located near the DI Ranch, west of Utah Hill in Washington County, Utah

Jurisdiction: Bureau of Land Management.

Fire Size: Approximately 900 acres. (Note: one acre is equivalent to one football field).

Cause: Lightning.

Fire Behavior: The fire is currently active and making short runs on one side.

Closures: No closures.

Structures: 10 structures are threatened. One of these structures is a residential home. The remaining 9 are out buildings, sheds, and/or stables.

Percent Contained: 75%

Fuels: Cheatgrass and brush.

Fire Crews/Resources: 7 Fire Engines, 1 Hand Crew, 2 Single Engine Air Tankers (SEATS), 1 Air Attack Platform, and Various Overhead. Approximately 65 personnel are assigned to the fire.

Evacuations: No evacuations are currently in effect.
