Diamond Valley Wildfire Fact Sheet 6:00 p.m. Update

Start Date: Saturday, August 6, 2011 at approximately 4:34 p.m.

Location: North Side of Diamond Valley Subdivision 7 miles north of St. George, Utah

Jurisdiction: Public and Private Lands

Fire Size: 104 acres confirmed by GPS

Cause: Human – Under investigation

Closure Information: Gubler-Blake Road still remains closed. However, the Goat Springs Road has reopened.
****Fire vehicles and personnel will remain in the area overnight, please use caution****

Evacuations: None

Structures Threatened: Threat to structures is currently being abated

Contained: 70%

Fuels: Pinyon, juniper and other vegetation

Fire Behavior: This afternoon fire crews experienced some minor torching and flare-ups

Fire Crews/Resources: Various resources including 4 wildland engines, 1 20-person handcrew and various overhead remain on scene working on mop up and monitoring efforts. Resources and staff fighting the fire include federal and state agencies.

Injuries: None

Other: The public is encouraged to please remain out of the general area of the fire for their safety as well as the safety of emergency personnel. Fire vehicles and personnel will remain in the area overnight, please use caution.
