Diamond Valley Wildfire Fact Sheet 8-8-11 9:00 a.m. Update

Start Date: Saturday, August 6, 2011 at approximately 4:34 p.m.

Location: North Side of Diamond Valley Subdivision 7 miles north of St. George, Utah

Jurisdiction: Public and Private Lands

Fire Size: 104 acres confirmed by GPS

Cause: Human – Under investigation

Closure Information: Gubler-Blake Road will remain closed until 5:00 p.m. August 8, 2011
****Fire vehicles and personnel will remain in the area, please use caution****

Evacuations: None

Structures Threatened: Threat to structures is currently being abated

Contained: 70%

Estimated Containment Date: Monday, August 08, 2011 at 5:00 p.m.

Fuels: Pinyon, juniper and other vegetation

Fire Behavior: There was no increase in fire activity overnight, minor hot spots are still being experienced in Alger Gulch/Wash

Fire Crews/Resources: Various resources including 4 wildland engines, 1 20-person handcrew and various overhead remain on scene working on mop up and monitoring efforts. Resources and staff fighting the fire include federal and state agencies.

Injuries: None

Other: The public is encouraged to remain out of the general area of the fire for their safety as well as the safety of emergency personnel.
