Greek Peak Wildfire management merges with MGC Complex

The management of the Greek Peak wildfire was assumed by the John Kidd Great Basin Type 2 Incident Management Team this morning at 06:00 a.m. The Greek Peak fire which is located 15 miles SW of Enterprise, and 6 miles SW of Enterprise Reservoir will be managed along with the 1,300 acre Middle Ridge fire which is 40% contained and the 1,500 acre Cottonwood fire which is also 40% contained. The Middle Ridge and Cottonwood wildfires are both located in Nevada. The three fires will now be known as the MGC complex. As firefighters continue to make progress on all three wildfires, fire officials request the public's assistance in keeping the area clear for fire crews to work and use extra caution with the increased fire traffic in these areas.
