Wildfire Fact Sheet

Summary: Color Country Fire resources are managing a fire located on the Arizona Strip near Quail Hill. The 340 acre lightning caused fire began July 2, 2014 at 6:15 p.m. Fire officials are requesting the public's assistance in keeping the area clear for fire crews to work. Fire officials also ask that those traveling along the Quail Hill BLM 1069 road proceed with caution as fire vehicles and resources are entering and exiting the roadway in the vicinity of the fire. No closures are currently in effect.

Start Date: Thursday July 4, 2014 6:15 p.m.

Location: Approximately 17 miles south of St. George Utah

Jurisdiction: BLM Arizona Strip District

Fire Size: 340

Cause: Lightning

Fire Behavior: creeping and smoldering

Closures: No closures are in effect

Structures: None

Percent Contained: 15%

Fuels: Cheatgrass, mixed brush, pinyon/juniper trees, and black brush

Fire Crews/Resources: On July 4, 2014 at 6 a.m. fire management transitioned from an initial attack team to a Type 3 team with the following resources; 4-20 person hand crews, 1 Type 4 engine, 1 Type 6 brush truck, 2 Water Tenders, a Type 2 Helicopter, air attack and Type 3 Moki Helitack.
