Hidden Fire Fact Sheet

Start Date: Saturday, July 11, 2011

Location: 25 miles southeast of Mesquite, Nevada

Jurisdiction: Bureau of Land Management

Cause: Lightning

Fire Size: 17,188 acres

Closures: None.

Structures: None threatened.

Percent Contained: 90 percent contained.

Fuels: Cheatgrass.

***American Reinvestment & Recovery Act (ARRA) Resource:** Funded through the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act, the newly constructed water tank located at the Pakoon Fire Station on the BLM Arizona Strip, made it possible for helicopters to obtain valuable resources in close proximity to the fire. The water tank's construction and location at the Pakoon Fire Station significantly aided suppression efforts and increased response times to minimize acreage burned.

Fire Crews/resources: 4 BLM engines, 1 Forest Service engine, 1 Bureau of Indian Affairs engine, 2 Santa Clara Fire Department engines, 1 Brian Head Fire Department engine, 1 Beaver Dam/Littlefield Department Fire engine, 1 water tender, 3 helicopters, 2 Southern Paiute Agency crew, 1 Color Country crew, one BLM fuels crews.
