## Hurricane Assist 2 Wildfire

**Summary:** *Firefighters continued their good progress in containing the fire yesterday. Containment lines were tested by strong, gusty winds throughout the day and all held. Red Flag conditions with gusty winds and low humidity are forecasted again for today. The fire is currently showing minimal activity with little smoke. There are no immediate threats to structures. Today firefighters will continue to mop-up any remaining hot spots. Full containment is expected by end of shift today. Numerous firefighting resources were released yesterday at the end of shift and made available for other fires.*

**Start Date:** Tuesday, May 22 @ 5:30 p.m.

**Location:** Just to the SE of Hurricane, UT, south of SR 59

**Jurisdiction:** Bureau of Land Management, State of Utah and private

**Fire Size:** Approximately 2,200 acres

**Percent Contained:** 90%. Full containment expected by end of shift today.

**Cause:** Human (No specific cause at this time. Investigation ongoing)

**Closures:** None

**Evacuations:** None

**Structures:** No structures lost or threatened

**Fuels:** Brush and cheatgrass

**Fire Crews/resources:** 4 wildland fire engines, 1 water tender, 1 helicopter and approximately 20 firefighters
