Summary: *Due to the hard work of the firefighters over the last few days, the fire is now fully contained. Firefighters will continue to monitor the fire for the next several days and mop-up any hot spots that may remain. There may still be smoke visible from the interior of the fire as some of the heavier fuels burn out.*

Location: Just to the SE of Hurricane, UT, south of SR 59

Jurisdiction: Bureau of Land Management, State of Utah and private

Fire Size: Approximately 2,200 acres

Percent Contained: 100%

Cause: Human (No specific cause at this time. Investigation ongoing)

Fuels: Brush and cheatgrass

Fire Crews/resources: 1 wildland engine with crew and other local resources
