Lava Wildland Fire Update

Start Date: Monday, July 25, 2011

Location: Approximately 60 miles southeast of St. George, Utah.

Jurisdiction: Bureau of Land Management, Arizona Strip District

Fire Size: Approximately 300 acres

Structures threatened: No

Vegetation Type: Ponderosa pine and mixed brush.

Fire Crews/Resources: The Type III Incident Management Team managing the fire includes a variety of interagency resources with one hot shot crew, one helicopter, two type two hand crews, one type one hand crew, five engines, and two water tenders.

Other: The fire is being managed for multiple objectives including achieving desired future conditions for the vegetation and protecting the values at risk including archeological sites and monument objects such as the ponderosa pine ecosystem and goshawk habitat.
