## Wildfire Fact Sheet

**Summary:** The New Harmony Wildfire is 90 percent contained and crews are working isolated hot spots. All evacuations have been lifted and are no longer in effect. Interstate 15, Highway 144 and Old Highway 91 are open and secure. Seven structures (homes/trailers), 22 out buildings (garages/sheds), and numerous vehicles were lost.

The fire perimeter did not increase due to effective firefighting efforts. A Color Country Type III Team is in command and is expecting to transition with a Type IV Incident Commander Sunday morning. The cause of this fire has been confirmed as a water pump malfunction located on private land in New Harmony, Utah.

Good "Defensible Space" on private land in conjunction with vegetation treatments on State and Bureau of Land Management (BLM) land, and effective firefighting efforts greatly contributed to many homes being saved.

**Start Date:** Wednesday, June 27, 2012 at 1:50 p.m.

**Location:** New Harmony, Utah, west of Interstate 15.

**Jurisdiction:** State of Utah.

**Fire Size:** 1,826 acres (Note: one acre is equivalent to one football field). The fire has accurately mapped via helicopter GPS mission.

**Cause:** Water Pump Malfunction

**Fire Behavior:** Fire behavior is minimal; crews are working isolated hot spots west of Interstate 15.

**Closures:** No closures are in effect.

**Structures:** Seven structures (homes/ trailers), 22 out buildings (garages/sheds), and numerous vehicles have been lost.

**Percent Contained:** 90%

**Fuels:** Cheatgrass, mixed brush, and pinyon/juniper trees.

**Fire Crews/Resources:** Approximately 1 Type III Helicopters, 15 Fire Engines, 1 Squad, 2 Hand Crews, 2 Water Tenders, and various Overhead. Jeramie Ybright's, Color Country Interagency Type III team is in command of the fire. Approximately 80 firefighters are on scene.

**Evacuations:** Evacuations are no longer in effect.

**Injuries:** One firefighter was burned with first and second degree burns Wednesday. He was treated and released at a local hospital. No other injuries have been reported today.
