Summary: The lightning caused, North Hills Fire ignited an estimated 300 acre wildfire Wednesday evening. Two structures are threatened but firefighters are making good progress on meeting containment objectives.

Start Date: Wednesday, August 1, 2012 8:30 p.m.

Location: Approximately two miles northwest of Enterprise, Utah.

Jurisdiction: Bureau of Land Management.

Fire Size: Approximately 300 acres. (Note: one acre is equivalent to one football field).

Cause: Lightning.

Fire Behavior: Fire behavior is minimal. Smoldering and creeping is being observed.

Structures: A radio communication tower and four structures are threatened.

Percent Contained: 25%

Fuels: Cheatgrass.

Fire Crews/Resources: 10 Fire Engines, 1 Water Tender, 2 Hand Crews, 1 Dozer, and Various Overhead. Approximately 90 personnel are assigned to the fire.

Comments: No closures or evacuations are in effect.
