## Wildfire Fact Sheet- Oak Grove Fire

### Summary:

**Start Date:** Tuesday, September 8, 2015 at 2:30 p.m.

**Location:** Three miles southeast of Oak Grove Campground, near Leeds, Utah.

**Jurisdiction:** Pine Valley Ranger, District Dixie National Forest

**Fire Size:** Estimated at 80 acres. (Note: one acre is equivalent to one football field).

**Cause:** Natural Cause

**Fire Behavior:** Torching, running, and spotting fire behavior is observed.

**Closures:** As a precaution Forest Service road #032 to Oak Grove and Oak Grove Campground are closed and the campground has been evacuated. The public and media is urged to use caution in the area to allow fire personnel access.

**Structures: Percent Contained: 0%**

**Fuels:** Pinyon and Juniper, Oak Brush, Mixed Conifer and Brush.

**Fire Crews/Resources:** Local resources on scene are 4 engines from Forest Service, Utah Division of Forestry, Fire and State Lands Utah State, and Bureau of Land Management. Orders have been placed for 2 hotshot crews, an Aerial Supervision aircraft (Air Attack), 4 Single engine air tankers (SEATS), and a Color Country Type 3 incident management team. Once Air attack is on scene we will have more accurate information and provide updates.

**Evacuations:** Oak Grove Campground was evacuated as a precaution

**Injuries:** No injuries have been reported.
