Wildfire Fact Sheet- Little Pine

Summary: The Little Pine Fire is located 5 miles SW of Enterprise in Washington County, UT. Fire activity was diminished yesterday on most of the fire area over what was experienced the first day. Late yesterday afternoon one area on the SE corner heated up and was active, creating a small column for a while. Aviation Resources were successful in holding the fire with little growth, creating opportunities for ground forces to create an anchor and begin containment efforts. A Color Country Type III team is managing the fire.

Start Date: Friday, August 10, 2012 11:48a.m.

Location: 5 miles South West of Enterprise in Washington County, Utah.

Jurisdiction: Dixie National Forest, Pine Valley Ranger District.

Fire Size: 2300 acres

Cause: Lightning.

Fire Behavior: Fire has some individual torching and creeping, minimal smoke is visible currently.

Closures: Possible closures on Hwy 120 due to fire conditions. Honeycomb Rocks Campground and Enterprise Reservoir area are closed to public access.

Structures: 12 structures threatened.

Percent Contained: 5%

Fuels: Pinyon, Juniper, Cheatgrass, Oak Brush and brush.

Fire Crews/Resources: Type III Team, 5 crews, 8 Fire Engines, 3 Helicopters, 2 Heavy Airtankers, 2 Single Engine Airtankers, 1 Air Attack, 1 Lead Plane, 2 Dozers.

Evacuations: Voluntary evacuation of Honeycomb Rocks campground and Enterprise Reservoir area are in effect.

Injuries: No injuries have been reported.
