Wildfire Fact Sheet- Solitude

Summary: This lightning caused fire is being managed to improve habitat and achieve other natural resource management objectives by reducing the amount of dead fuels and create openings in the mixed conifer to allow for aspen regeneration in the area. Decisions are also based on firefighter, aviator, and public safety as well. Today, firefighters will continue to **construct fireline along Forest Road 096 from Hans Ridge junction north to the ridge between Newts and Strawberry Canyon** by cutting the brush back and remove other fuels from the road.
