



# Fishlake National Forest

## Solitude Fire Update

**Time of info:** August 7, 2015, 9:00 a.m.

**Summary:** This lightning-caused wildfire is being managed to improve habitat and achieve other natural resource management objectives by reducing the amount of dead fuels and create openings in the mixed conifer to allow for aspen regeneration in the area. Decisions are also based on firefighter, aviator, and public safety. Firefighters will continue to treat vegetation along roads and along designated ridges in order to confine the fire to desired location. A small wetting trend with storms is predicted for today. The Fire is not out. We expect varying levels of fire activity over the course of the next week or longer. Fire activity is likely to increase during drying periods and slow during the wet periods.

**Start Date and Location:** July 19, 2015, 15:15 pm; Pahvant Range, approximately 10 miles NW of Richfield

**Jurisdiction:** Fillmore Ranger District, Fishlake National Forest

**Fire Size:** 2,175 acres

**Cause:** Lightning

**Fire Behavior:** Minimal growth with some smoldering and creeping; also had some single tree torching

**Closures:** An area closure is now in place. Fire conditions and operations require that FR 096 along the top of the mountain be closed from the junction of the 096 and Forest Service Road 1743 to the Chalk Creek Road Junction to allow for public and fire fighter safety. The area to be closed includes all access points into the fire at appropriate locations on the Forest.

**Percent Completed:** 25%

**Fuels:** Timber with aspen and sagebrush/grass

**Fire Crews/Resources:** 1-Type 3 Overhead Team-Nelson/Rasmussen (T), 2-Type Heavy Engine, 2-Type Light Engine, 2-Type 2 Hand crews, 1-Type 1 Hand crew, 1-Type 3 Helicopter.

**FIRE AREA CLOSURE  
Solitude Fire**

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited in the areas described in this order, on the Fillmore Ranger District, Fishlake National Forest until further notice:

1. To go into or be upon the area described below, which is closed for the protection of public health and safety. [Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)]

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempted from the prohibition contained in this Order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(d)(1)]
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer; or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)]
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**AREA DESCRIBED:**

The closed area is depicted on the map attached as Exhibit A, and specifically described as follows

- Beginning at the junction of Forest Service Road 096 and Forest Service Road 100 (T21S, R2.5W, Sec. 27),
- Thence south and southwest along Forest Service Road 096 to the junction of Forest Service Road 096 and Forest Service Road 1743 in (T22S, R3W, Sec. 22).
- Thence southeast along a line between Newts Canyon and Mill Canyon to the junction of the Newt Canyon Trail and the Mill Canyon Trail at T22S, R2.5W, Sec 27, thence east to the Forest Service Boundary along the South Cedar Ridge Canyon Trail at T22S, R2W, Sec 28,
- Thence north along the Forest Boundary to Forest Road 911 thence to the Red Canyon Trail 015 and west to the junction with Forest Service Road 102 at (T21S, R2.5W, Sec 24,)
- Thence southwest, east of Forest Service Road 102 to the point of origin. (T21S, R2.5W, Sec. 27).

**PURPOSE/DURATION:**

This order is temporary and is intended for public safety during wildland fire operations.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**



1. This order will be in effect when signed at the point of restriction.
2. A map identifying the areas that may be restricted is attached and made part of this order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7)}.

5. This order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order in the areas covered by this order.
