New Fire Burning on the Fishlake National Forest

RICHFIELD, UT- Fire crews responded to a new fire on the Fishlake National Forest Monday afternoon. The lightning caused South Water Hollow fire is burning approximately 8 miles northwest of Fremont Junction. Estimated at 14 acres, the fire is burning in brush, pinyon juniper and Ponderosa pine. Fire behavior is described as creeping, with isolated, single tree torching.

Fire managers are assessing the future management of the fire. No structures are threatened.
