

Project Location: The Greenville Bench is located approximately six miles south of Beaver, Utah, and west of Interstate 15.

Implementation: This project will be implemented in 2011 in addition to various treatments conducted in the past. This is in partnership with the Utah Watershed Restoration Initiative (UWRI).
