Coffee Pot Fire Area Closure

The Manti-La Sal National Forest announced Tuesday, September 21, 2010 the temporary closure of the following trails and roads due to the Coffee Pot Fire.

These closures are to provide for public and firefighter safety.

The closure area includes the:

**Coffee Pot Trail (FST #327)
Dipping Pen Trail (FST#330)
Lake Fork Road (FSR #070) from the National Forest Boundary on the north, to the
junction of the Lake Fork and Dairy Fork roads on the south.
Right Fork-Lake Fork Trail (FST #326)
Smith Reservoir Road (FSR #232)
Sweat Creek Trail (FST #042)**

The Coffee Pot Fire is a lightning-caused fire which is being managed due to unsafe terrain for fire personnel and to improve wildlife habitat. The fire is currently 690 acres.

The closure areas will be reopened as soon as the area is deemed safe for the public.
