EMERGENCY FIRE CLOSURE

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following act is prohibited on the roads and trails as described in this order, all within the Sanpete Ranger District, Manti-La Sal National Forest until further notice.

1. Use by any type of vehicle prohibited by the order; (motorized, non-motorized or mechanized), 36 CFR 261.54(a).
2. Use by any type of vehicle prohibited by the order; (motorized, non-motorized, mechanized), 36 CFR 261.55(b).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

All National Forest System Roads and Trails located within the area affected by the Coffee Pot Fire, located in Utah County, Utah, Township 10 South, Range 4 East, Sections 11 thru 15, 19 thru 36; Township 10 South, Range 5 East, Sections 19 thru 21, 28 thru 36; Township 11 South, Range 4 East, Sections 1 thru 13, 24, 26, and 34; Township 11 South, Range 5 East, Sections 5 thru 8, and 18, Salt Lake Base & Meridian, as depicted on attached map (EXHIBIT A) and described below:

Roads and Trails affected by Fire Closure:

- Right Fork Lake Trail (Forest Service Trail) (FST) # 326
- Coffee Pot (Forest Service Trail) (FST) # 327
- Sweat Creek Trail (Forest Service Trail) (FST) # 042
- Dipping Pen (Forest Service Trail) (FST) # 330
- Smith Reservoir (Forest Service Road) (FSR) # 232
- Lake Fork Road (Forest Service Road) (FSR) # 070


PURPOSE:

The purpose of the ORDER is to protect life and property due to hazards from the Coffeepot Fire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in the above- described area.
