Anasazi Wildfire Fact Sheet

Start Date: Saturday, July 23, 2011 at approximately 12:40 p.m.

Location: Approximately 1 mile west of Ivins, Utah

Jurisdiction: Private, State of Utah and Bureau of Indian Affairs-Southern Paiute Agency

Fire Size: Confirmed by GPS at 215 acres

Cause: Human (grinding of metal)

Closure Information: Old Highway 91 west of Ivins will reopen July 23, 2011 at 7:30 p.m. *Fire vehicles and personnel will remain in the area, please use caution*

Evacuations: No evacuations in affect

Structures Threatened: Threat to structures is currently being abated

Contained: 40% contained as of 7:00 p.m. with full containment estimated for July 24, 2011

Fuels: Cheatgrass and other vegetation

Fire Crews/Resources: 2 light helicopters, 1 aerial supervision platform, 3 single engine air tankers, 13 wildland engines, 1-20 person hand crew. Resources and staff fighting the fire include Bureau of Indian Affairs-Southern Paiute Agency, BLM Arizona Strip, Utah Division of Forestry, Fire & State Lands, Zion National Park, and local municipal fire departments including Santa Clara, Diamond Valley, and Color Country Districts.
