Wood Hollow Fire Update

June 30, 2012

The Wood Hollow Fire has burned approximately 47,295 acres since its start on June 24. The fire is now 65% contained with the estimated containment date of today at 12:00 P.M. The fire spread into Utah County has been checked.

The Evacuation Order, for Indian Ridge, Oaker Hills, Elk Ridge and Birdseye communities, have been lifted and land owners will be returning home today. 160 structures were destroyed by the fire, 52 of those were primary dwellings, in Sanpete County. The investigation into the cause of the fire is continuing.

Today is the first day, since the incident started, there are no Red Flag Warnings predicted for the afternoon. This will aid the fire fighters in their efforts to control the fire. The fire fighters are starting to mop up and do fire line rehabilitation.

Personnel has started to be re-assigned to other fires leaving 866 personnel on the Wood Hollow fire.

The American Red Cross shelter in Mt. Pleasant has been closed, and a Red Cross service center will open in Indianola. The location will be announced later.
