Incident Name: Indian Fire

Date: July 20, 2014 PM

Time: 1900

Start Date: July 19, 2014 Reported at 8:00 PM

Location: Weber County, east of Ogden, Utah. The fire is located east of 24th Street, South of 12th Street.

Cause: Suspected human caused, under investigation

Size: Mapped by GPS at 50 acres

Fuels: Grass, oak brush, timber

Resources: 2 crews, 4 engines, 1 helicopter, approx. 65 firefighters

Fire Behavior: creeping and smoldering

Containment: 70%

Evacuations: Approx. 20 homes were evacuated on July 19th. All residents have returned to their homes.

Closures: No closures are currently in effect, however for firefighter and public safety fire officials are requesting the public's assistance in keeping the area clear for fire crews to work. Please do not use the Bonneville Shoreline Trail from 12th Street South to Water Fall Canyon.

Remarks: The Indian fire is in steep, rocky terrain in Weber County, East of Ogden, Utah. The fire is located east of 24th Street and South of 12th street. The fire is creeping and smoldering under the oak brush. Crews will continue to construct line and extinguish hot spots. Helicopter will continue to support the crews with water drops. Smoke may continue to be visible from the Ogden Valley.

The fire is being managed by a local Interagency Type III Incident Management Team.
