



## Final Anaconda Fire Fact Sheet

**Incident Name:** Anaconda Fire

**Date:** July 24, 2014

**Time:** 9:00 p.m.

**Start Date:** July 20, 2014 Reported at 8:00p.m.

**Location:** The fire is located 5 miles northeast of Tooele, Utah

**Cause:** Lightning

**Size:** Approx. 1140 acres: BLM 227 acres and Private 913 acres

**Fuels:** Grass, sage, oak brush, and juniper

**Resources:** 1 hand crew and 2 engines

**Fire Behavior:** smoldering

**Containment:** 95%

**Evacuations:** Approx. 15 homes were evacuated on the evening of July 21st. All residents have returned to their homes.

**Closures:** Roads leading in and around the fire are closed for public safety.

**Remarks:** This will be the final update on the Anaconda fire. The fire will be turned over to the local Type 4 Management. They will continue to patrol and put out any remaining hotspots. The Type III Incident Management Team is heading to the Black Fire located in the Sheeprock Range.
