RED LEDGE FIRE UPDATE JULY 20, 2016

Salt Lake City, Utah, July 20, 2016 - The Red Ledge Fire, located 2 miles east of Currant Creek, on the Heber-Kamas Ranger District remains at 290 acres. Fire activity has decreased the last few days. There is some internal smoldering, which continues reduce build-up of dead woody material on the forest floor. Smoke may be visible from surrounding areas for several days and weeks but is expected to be minimal.

Resources include: one helicopter, Weber Basin Job Corp 20 person crew, Kings Peak 10 person Wildland Fire Module, and one engine.

All Currant Creek recreation and camping areas are open. Forest users visiting the Currant Creek area please be aware that fire personnel are and will be traveling on Forest Service road #080 (below Currant Creek Dam) for at least the next week.
