

## **FIRE PREVENTION ORDER RESCINDED**

Order No: UT-020-12-03

Effective 00:01 a.m. on Friday, September 7, 2012, the following fire restrictions on Bureau of Land Management (BLM) managed lands within the Color Country District Office and Grand Staircase Escalante National Monument, Utah are rescinded:

Pursuant to regulations of the Department of Interior, **43 CFR 9212** the following acts are prohibited on the area, roads, and trails, described below until rescinded by the Color Country District Manager, Bureau of Land Management:

1. Setting, building, maintaining, attending, or using open fire of any kind (including charcoal) except as otherwise authorized. This includes all fires in developed areas and previously approved sites. Devices fueled by petroleum or liquid propane gas (LPG) products are allowed in all locations.
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle, camp trailer, or building, or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared to mineral soil.
3. Discharging, or using any kind of fireworks, tracer ammunition, or other incendiary devices in any location on federal lands.
4. Operating a motorcycle, chainsaw, ATV, or other types of small engines without an approved and working spark arrester.

Individuals violating this order can be subject to fines and associated fire suppression and rehabilitation costs. **43 CFR 9212.4**


### **The following persons are exempt from the order:**

All other fire restrictions, or necessary exemptions to the restrictions, will be handled through local "permits" issues by the responsible agency(s) for that purpose.

### **Area Description:**

All BLM lands located in Washington, Iron, Beaver, Kane, Garfield, Sevier, Sanpete, Piute, and Wayne Counties are covered in this order. This order super cedes all other fire restriction orders previously issued by the agency: Order No.UT-020-12-01 and Order No.UT-020-12-02.
