FIRE PREVENTION ORDER – UT-020-13-01

Pursuant to regulations of the Department of Interior, found at 43 CFR 9212.1 (h), the additional following acts are prohibited on Bureau of Land Management lands, roads, waterways, and trails, in the State of Utah, until rescinded by the Color Country District Manager and Grand Staircase Escalante National Monument District Manager.

Acts prohibited under this order include the following:

- No campfires, except in permanently constructed cement or metal fire pits provided in developed campgrounds and picnic areas.
- Grinding, cutting and welding metal.
- Operating or using any internal or external combustion engine without a spark arresting device properly installed, maintained and in effective working order.
- Detonation of fireworks and exploding targets/devices (Please See Fire Prevention Order No. UT910-13-002).

Permissible Acts

- ✓ Devices fueled by petroleum or liquid petroleum gas in all locations.
- ✓ Charcoal burning in developed campgrounds or picnic grounds within permanent fire rings or grills constructed of metal or concrete. In undeveloped camping locations, charcoal must be set in metal pans in areas clear of flammable vegetation within three diameter feet.

The following persons are exempt from the order:


All exemptions to the restrictions are obtained through local “permits” issued by the authorized officer for activities that will not conflict with the purpose of the order (43 CFR 9212.3).


Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Area Description:

BLM, Color Country District and Grand Staircase Escalante National Monument administered public lands in the Counties of Washington, Iron, Beaver, Kane, and Garfield. This order is effective 12:01 a.m., the 20 Day of June, 2013 and will remain in effect until rescinded.

Individuals violating this order can be subject to fines up to and including \$1000 along with associated fire suppression and rehabilitation costs pursuant to 43 CFR 9212.
