Subject: Emergency Fire Restrictions Rescinded

Due to recent rainfall and cooler Fall temperatures, fire restrictions for Arches and Canyonlands National Parks, and Natural Bridges and Hovenweep National Monuments, have been lifted effective 12:00 a.m. Tuesday, September 27, 2016.

- Fires are permitted only in designed fire grates in developed campgrounds and picnic areas.
- Petroleum fueled stoves and grills are permitted in designated backcountry campsites, as well as developed campgrounds and picnic areas.
- Smoking is again allowed in the parks, and visitors are reminded to properly extinguish all lighted smoking materials.
- Fireworks are prohibited in all areas (they are always prohibited).
- On the river corridor, charcoal and wood fires are allowed, and must be fully contained in a fire pan.
