FIRE PREVENTION ORDER – UTAH BLM LANDS

United States Department the Interior

Bureau of Land Management

Order No. UT910-17-001

Pursuant to regulations of the Department of Interior, found at 43 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 9212.1 (h), the additional following acts are prohibited on Bureau of Land Management (BLM) areas, lands, roads, waterways, and trails, in the State of Utah, until rescinded by the Utah BLM State Director.

Acts prohibited under this order include the following:

- * The non-commercial use/discharge of explosives of any kind, incendiary or chemical devices, pyrotechnic devices, exploding targets, pressurized containers or canisters and binary explosives.
- * The use/discharge of any kind of fireworks as defined by this order.

Definition(s):

Fireworks- includes, but is not limited to, any device which produces noise, smoke, showers of sparks, or movement by combustion or explosive materials. These explosives are defined by the U.S. Department of Transportation in 49 CFR 173. This definition includes all classes of fireworks.

Binary explosive- includes, but is not limited to, pre-packaged products consisting of two separate components, usually an oxidizer like ammonium nitrate and a fuel such as aluminum or another metal. These binary explosives are defined by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives in 27 CFR 555.

The following persons are exempt from the order:

All other fire restrictions, or necessary exemptions to these restrictions, will be handled through local "permits" issued by BLM District Managers for that purpose.

Area description:

All BLM administered public lands in the State of Utah. This order is effective 12:01 a.m., 1st day of July, 2017, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

Individuals violating this order can be subject to fines up to and including \$1000 along with associated fire suppression and rehabilitation costs pursuant to 43 CFR 9212.4 and 43 CFR 9239. This order will supersede and rescind all previous fire prevention orders issued by this office.
