*Fire Restriction Order

(Box Elder, Cache, Rich and Weber Counties)

Due to current and forecasted weather conditions coupled with the extremely dry condition and heavy loading of vegetation throughout the State of Utah, the State Forester has determined that measures must be taken to prevent costly and damaging forest and rangeland fires. Therefore, pursuant to Utah State Law, Section 65A-8-212 Utah Code 1994. The **following acts are prohibited** on the areas, roads and trails described in the "Area Description" section below (Box Elder, Cache, Rich and Weber counties) until rescinded by the Utah State Forester:

Igniting, building, maintaining, or using a fire, including charcoal and briquettes, outside an approved fire pit within a designated area, (All developed recreation sites [campgrounds and picnic areas and permanent places of habitation] that are maintained and administered by an agency or home owner, and have a permanent fire structure). Stoves or grills that are fueled solely by liquid petroleum fuels are allowed.

Discharging, or using any kind of fireworks.

Area Description:


All unincorporated private and state lands within Box Elder, Cache, Rich and Weber counties.

Effective 12:01 A.M., 10th day of July, 2015.

Violation of the above prohibited acts is punishable as a class B misdemeanor.
