COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Over the past few years the State of Utah has been experiencing a higher frequency of both wildland and urban interface fires. The intent of the Utah Wildland Engine Training is to gather personnel from multiple fire departments in one location to train. Our objective is to refresh our understanding of wildland fire tactics and strategies, by utilizing hands-on training. This training will have some basic and advanced principles, but is geared toward the Engine Captain / Engineer level with more advanced concepts and tactics.
